

GOLFER OF THE MONTH RULES

MGA members can achieve the Golfer of the Month once per calendar year. An MGA member with a round to be considered for Golfer of the Month must submit his scorecard with his signature and the signatures of all who played with him verifying the round was completed under the rules of medal play (no conceded putts, pick-ups or adjusted scores). At least one witness must be a current ECG&T golf member (including WGC, Weekend, or Afternoon member). The hole-by-hole scores must be recorded on the card of the course played and contain the date of play, the tees (circled), and GOM.

The Formula for determining winners:

1. Gross Division: Gross score – course rating = differential (lowest wins). Ties use USGA recommended tiebreaker. (back 9, last 6, etc.)
2. Net Divisions: (Gross score – course rating) x multiplier = differential. Then subtract differential from player's handicap index = GOM score (highest wins).

Course ratings for the tees:

Conquistador: Black 72.4, Blue 70.4, Green 68.5, White 66.8, Red 63.0

Canada: Black 72.0, Blue 69.8, Green 68.7, White 67.4, Red 64.3

Multipliers (which = 113/slope):

Conquistador: Black .876, Blue .904, Green .911, White .926, Red .991

Canada: Black .837, Blue .876, Green .890, White .911, Red .974
